INTRODUCTION

In the field of Slavic and East European studies, the University of Toronto Library has a collection of considerable strength and scope, which has major national and international value in the academic world. Approximately ten percent of our extensive Slavic collection, or about 50,000 plus volumes, is comprised of Ukrainian-language material, and is a resource of major significance and one that supports a broad range of advanced research and teaching.

The main strength of the Ukrainian collection in Robarts Library is in the fields of literature and history. The leading writers and thinkers of the 19th and 20th centuries are well represented by the finest critical editions of their works and criticism on them, as are bibliographies, standard surveys, and multivolume histories. Many retrospective serials are available. For example, we hold in microform the Petro Jacyk Collection of Ukrainian Serials that consists of 175 newspapers and periodicals published in Western Ukraine (Galicia, Bukovina, Transcarpathia) during the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Robarts Library also has extensive holdings of publications of Ukrainian scholarly societies, such as the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine and the Shevchenko Scientific Society.

The Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library, a part of the University of Toronto Library system, contains a number of rare volumes of Ucrainica from the early 17th century to the present, including examples of manuscripts, old printing, and first editions. It also houses special collections, such as the Peter J. Potichnyj collection on the insurgent and counter-insurgent movements in Ukraine. Further Ukrainian material at the Fisher Library pertains to the émigré experience and is part of the John Luczkiw collections of Ukrainian publications by displaced persons or political refugees, and Ukrainian émigrés in Canada.

Additional Ukrainian library material is housed in several specialized collections on the University campus: Fine Art, Music, Mediaeval Studies—which holds material on the history of Kyivan Rus' and Muscovy (i.e., from the 9th to the beginning of the 17th century)—Law, University Archives, Media Commons, and the Petro Jacyk Resource Centre.
