COVERAGE The collection includes approximately 100,000 entries and approximately 200 reference sources published between 1711 to 1995. It covers biographical information on individuals influential in the shaping of Albania, Bulgaria, Romania, Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Macedonia, Serbia, and Montenegro. These reference sources are written not only in South-East European languages such as Romanian, Bulgarian, Albanian, Serbo-Croatian, Slovenian, and Macedonian, but also in German, English, French, and Italian.

The Archive covers the period from the 9th century to the present day men and women who have influenced the cultural, political, religious, and economic life of this region have been included in this Archive such as historians, philosophers, writers, poets, musicians, painters, artists, actors, sportsmen and -women, architects, journalists, scientists, physicists, engineers, lawyers, clerics, theologians, army officers, politicians, monarchs, and aristocrats.
